Summary Report - All University Respondents

The survey was open February-March 2021 during the COVID-19 pandemic, while the University was conducting classes and staff work remotely. Invitations were emailed to 9,000 students, faculty and staff. More than 2,800 responses were received: 60% from staff, 26% from students and 12% from faculty. The survey was promoted to adjacent neighborhood organizations by email and received 51 responses.







4. Which types of places enrich your experience on the Twin Cities Campus? (Select up to five)





5. What types of student life spaces are most important for creating a sense of community?(Select all that apply)






6. What types of academic spaces are most important for student success? (Select all that apply)









9. What two factors have most influenced your housing choices while you have worked at UMN




10. Before COVID-19 conditions, what kinds of activities did you typically do near campus? (Select




11. What kinds of activities near campus would you like to do in the future? (Select all that apply)




12. In which area(s) of campus do you spend most of your time? Choose as many or as few as you wish.






13. On a scale of 1 to 10, where 1 is not easy at all and 10 is very easy, how easy is it for you to get around campus outdoors?







15. What is your primary mode of transportation when commuting to campus?






19. How often do you typically drive to/from campus?



21. Do you drive an electric vehicle to/from campus?



22. What are your primary reasons for driving to/from campus? (Select all that apply)


